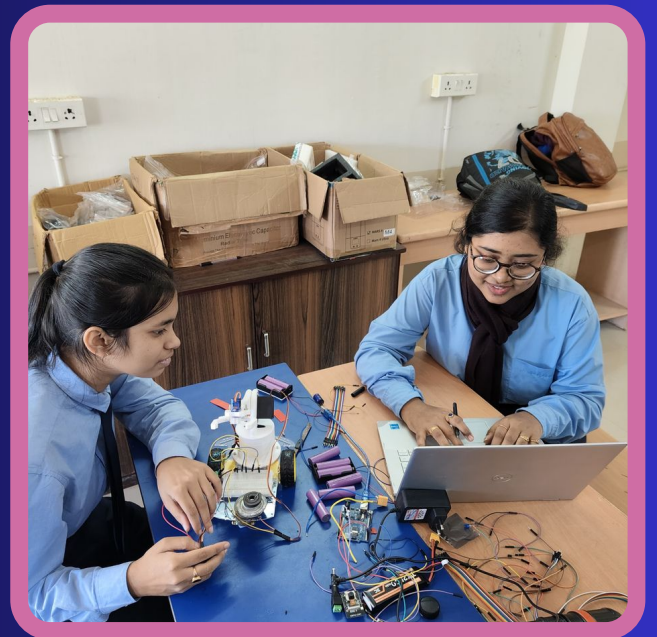
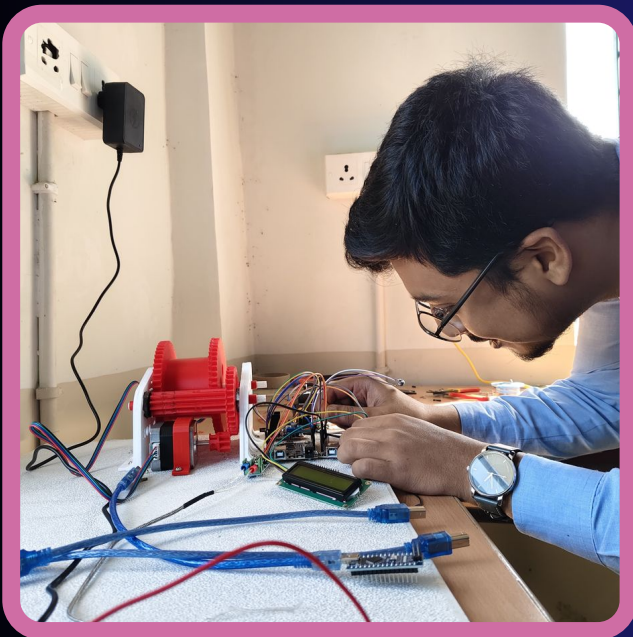
ADVANCE MANUFACTURING & AUTOMATION LAB

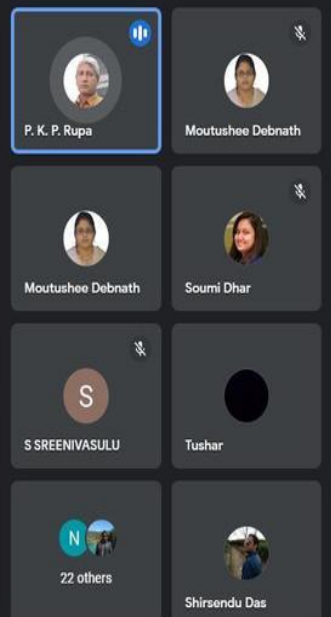
